Programs to provide response services and/or counseling to battered women. Counseling services include, but are not limited to, short or long-term counseling by peers, volunteers or professionals, legal and financial advice, and referral of appropriate resources.	
Alcohol/Drug Abuse	2 - 3
Programs to prevent and treat problems of alcohol/drug abuse and/or misuse. Counseling and other support services to families of alcoholics.	
Child Abuse	3
Programs to provide support services to children and youth (under the age of 18) who are in danger of neglect, abuse or exploitation. May include counseling for parents/guardians of abused or neglected children. 0-5 Programs-Programs for Pre-School Children.	
Child Care	3
Programs that provide childcare for preschool-age children.	
Community Services	3
Provides additional information & referral services to public community agencies.	
Counseling	4 - 5
Programs assisting individuals or families who are experiencing social and emotional problems. Assistance in developing personal growth and improving communication within the family.	
Crisis Intervention	5
Programs which provide face-to-face immediate response services to emotionally-distressed persons who are in life-threatening situations.	
Emergency Services	5 - 6
Health care facilities capable of diagnosing and treating persons with acute life-threatening conditions or severe illness on a 24-hour basis. Law enforcement agencies included.	
Food Assistance Services	6
Health Services	6 - 7
Programs which help achieve and maintain physical well-being as well as preventing and treating acute or chronic disease, illness, injury.	
Homeless Services	7 - 8
Legal Services	7 - 8
Programs which provide professional or non-professional assistance directed at assessing and resolving individual, family or group legal problems and needs.
