## 2012 GRAD NIGHT AGREEMENT/PARENT PERMISSION FORM

### AHS Student Agreement

I realize that Grad Night is an important and exciting event and at the same time, I agree that one's safety is vitally important. Therefore, I agree not to use drugs or alcohol prior to, during, or after Grad Night.

Furthermore, I understand that I am accountable for my own actions. Should this agreement be violated, the consequences for Azusa High School students may be the loss of privilege to attend all remaining school activities through the end of the school year.

### Parent Agreement

I give my approval for my son/daughter to attend Grad Night, to be held on **Thursday, June 7, 2012 from 9:00 PM to 7:00 AM on Friday, June 8 at Disneyland, in Anaheim, CA.**

Under the provisions of Education Code 1081.5 all persons attending shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the Azusa Unified School District or the State of California for injury, accident, illness or death occurring during or by reason of this activity.

I hereby give school personnel my permission to select a physician and permit that physician to institute the necessary treatment for my son/daughter in case of any emergency.

As a parent/guardian of the named student, I agree not to furnish or condone the use of illegal drugs or alcohol by my son or daughter. I support the enforcement of the above stated consequences.

**I hereby give school personnel permission to contact me should my son or daughter violate school directives or participate in drinking or drugs.** I realize that violation of school or Grad Night rules may result in my having to pick up my son/daughter at the above named Grad Night location and no refund will be given.

### Student Dress Code

- A. All clothing must be suitable for school: Neat, clean, in good repair, size appropriate, and not grayed.
- B. Clothing and jewelry shall be free of writing, pictures, or any other insignia which:
  - 1.) are crude, violent, vulgar, profane, prejudicial, or sexually suggestive.
  - 2.) advocate the use of drugs or alcohol.
  - 3.) by manner of being worn indicate an affiliation with a group or gang which may provoke violence or cause others to be intimidated.
- C. belt buckles with lettering are not allowed, and the length of the belt shall be appropriate for waist size.
- D. Hats, caps, head covering, bandannas and hair nets, shall **not** be worn.
- E. Clothes shall be sufficient to conceal undergarments. See-through or fishnet fabrics, spaghetti straps, halter tops, off-the-shoulder or low cut tops, tank tops, bare midribs, and skirts or shorts shorter than mid-thigh are prohibited.
- F. Shoes must be worn at all times. Thongs, thong-like sandals, and steel toed shoes are **not** acceptable.

In addition: Students shall not be allowed to wear buttons, badges, or other insignia which promote graffiti, the use of spray cans or weapons.

Disneyland also includes the following Dress Code:

#### Unacceptable for Everyone:

- Any clothing affiliated with a school, sports team, group, club, etc. (i.e. letterman jackets, clothing with school logos, etc.).
- Clothing not in good repair (torn jeans, shirts, etc.).
- Extremely revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suit tops or bottoms, see-through clothing, etc.).
- Hats.
- All backpacks, briefcases, hop packs, camera bags, tote bags and oversized purses.
- Cameras, cell phones and pagers are OK if not in a case.
- Shoes with skate wheels.
- Weapons, knives, chemical irritants of any kind, laser pointers.
- Food and beverage (including water bottles and snack items).
- Prescription medication (inhalers are OK).
- Over the counter medications.
- Tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, snuff, etc.) and related material (lighters, matches, pipes, etc.).
- Alcohol or any controlled substance.
